## **ITEMS FOR ALL PARTICIPANTS**

- o Informal, comfortable clothing is appropriate for all daily activities.

- o Comfortable, closed-toed shoes.

- Pencil with eraser for all rehearsals

- Backpack or other bag

## **ITEMS FOR INSTRUMENTALISTS**

  - $\circ$   $\;$  Reeds, Valve oil, cleaning supplies, cup for reed water, etc.
- Make sure your instrument is in excellent playing condition. It is less expensive to have repairs done at home than in an emergency at CSI. Parents/guardians are responsible for the costs of any repairs incurred during CSI.
