## Packing List

### ITEMS FOR ALL PARTICIPANTS

- Informal, comfortable clothing is appropriate for all daily activities.
  - For the final performance, musicians will wear **concert black**.
- Comfortable, closed-toed shoes.
- Pajamas
- Bath towel/washcloth
- Shower shoes
- Soap, toothbrush, deodorant, and other personal toiletries
- **Bed linens** (dorm beds are twin XL)
- Blanket, pillow(s)
- Sweatshirt/Sweatpants (dorms are air-conditioned)
- Rain jacket/other gear if necessary
- Sunscreen
- Reusable water bottle (students will not be provided daily bottled water)
- Pencil with eraser for all rehearsals
- Phone charger
- Backpack or other bag
- Students may wish to bring spending money for snacks or souvenirs from the University bookstore. We recommend between \$25-\$40. This must be cash. Baldwin Wallace accepts no responsibility for lost or stolen money or personal items.
- NO refrigerators, televisions, or appliances.

\*\*Be sure to label all of your personal belongings.

### ITEMS FOR INSTRUMENTALISTS

- Cellists and bassists are required to bring a rock-stop/endpin cover to use during camp.
- Necessary accessories for your instrument:
  - Rosin, shoulder-rest, cleaning cloth, extra strings, etc.
  - Reeds, Valve oil, cleaning supplies, cup for reed water, etc.
- Make sure your instrument is in excellent playing condition. It is less expensive to have repairs done at home than in an emergency at CSI. Parents/guardians are responsible for the costs of any repairs incurred during CSI.

\*\*All instruments will be locked in an assigned classroom for storage when not in use.

\*\*Baldwin Wallace is not responsible for any instrument damage or lost items during camp.

\*\*While the campus is safe and secure and instruments will be locked, we recommend that you check to make sure your instrument is insured.
