Packing List

ITEMS FOR ALL CAMPERS

- All items, especially those that can be misplaced during the day (water bottles, backpacks), should be labeled with the camper's name.
- o Informal, comfortable clothing is appropriate for all daily activities.
 - For the final performance, campers will wear the provided camp t-shirt with <u>dark</u> <u>bottoms</u> (no skirts).
- Comfortable, closed-toed shoes
- Rain jacket/other gear if necessary
- o String bag, backpack, or other bag to carry daily materials.
- o Swimsuit (students **must** have a swimsuit if they intend to swim at the pool)
 - \circ Appropriate swimwear will be left to the discretion of the guardians.
 - Plastic bag for wet/damp swim gear
- o Sunscreen & Towel
- Reusable water bottle (students will not be provided daily bottled water)
- Pencil with eraser for all rehearsals
- Students may wish to bring spending money for snacks, pizza, and souvenirs from the University bookstore. We recommend between \$25-40. This must be cash. Baldwin Wallace accepts no responsibility for lost or stolen money or personal items.

ADDITIONAL ITEMS FOR RESIDENTIAL CAMPERS

- o Sweatshirt/Sweatpants (dorms are air-conditioned)
- Pajamas
- o Bath towel, washcloth
- \circ Shower shoes
- \circ Soap, toothbrush, deodorant, and other personal toiletries
- Bed linens (dorm rooms are twin XL)
- Blanket, pillow(s)
- Phone charger (if applicable)
- o NO refrigerators, televisions, or appliances

**Be sure to label all of your personal belongings.

***Students MUST wear shoes at all times (except when in the dance studio – Music Theatre only).

ITEMS FOR INSTRUMENTALISTS

- All instrumentalists should ensure their instrument is labeled with their name before arriving on campus.
- **Cellists and bassists** are required to bring a rock-stop/endpin cover to use during camp.
- Necessary accessories for your instrument:
 - Rosin, shoulder-rest, cleaning cloth, extra strings, etc.
 - \circ $\;$ Reeds, Valve oil, cleaning supplies, cup for reed water, etc.
- Make sure your instrument is in excellent playing condition. It is less expensive to have repairs done at home than in an emergency at camp. Parents/guardians are responsible for the costs of any repairs incurred during camp.

**All instruments will be locked in an assigned classroom for storage when not in use.
